Having considered the parties' briefing and oral arguments in this matter, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The superior court's rulings and final judgment appealed by the Lieutenant Governor and the Division of Elections are AFFIRMED.
- 2. The Lieutenant Governor requested that this court approve his inclusion of a new sentence in the ballot summary paragraph regarding Section 7 of the initiative act to replace the sentence stricken by the superior court; that request is GRANTED IN PART in light of Vote Yes For Alaska's Fair Share's acknowledgment at oral argument that it had no concern with a portion of that sentence.
