## Notice of Oral Argument

Oral argument will be held before the Court of Appeals in on **Wednesday, 2/5/2020 at 10:45 AM**. The parties will have **30 minutes per side** to present their arguments.

If this date or time is unsuitable, counsel shall notify the court by filing a motion to continue oral argument. This motion must be filed no later than **Friday, 12/27/2019**. Absent extraordinary, unforeseeable circumstances, any request to reschedule or continue oral argument filed after this deadline will be denied. Any request to waive oral argument filed after this deadline may result in monetary sanctions.

Counsel seeking a rescheduling of argument shall confer with non-moving counsel and advise the court of all parties' positions on the motion, as well as any mutually acceptable alternate dates.

If counsel is unavailable at the particular time or on the particular day scheduled for argument, the clerk will probably be able to reschedule the argument for another time that day or another day that week. In such instances, counsel should call the clerk's office to obtain an acceptable alternate date and time for the argument. However, if counsel is unavailable that week, the court will automatically reschedule the argument for the following month's oral argument calendar, unless counsel requests otherwise.
