
On consideration of the Motion to Reconsider the 4/11/2022 Order allowing *amicus* Alaska Legislative Council's reply brief, filed by the State on 4/11/2022, and the opposition filed by Alaska Legislative Council on 4/12/2022,

IT IS ORDERED: Reconsideration is **DENIED**. Although our 3/02/2022 order was not intended to invite an *amicus curiae* to file more than one brief, we recognize the order's ambiguity. Because of that ambiguity, and the Alaska Legislative Council's apparent reliance on it, we will allow the reply brief in this circumstance.
