Before the court is Appellant's motion for a stay of the decision and order below, pending resolution of Appellant's appeal to this court. But it appears undisputed that Appellant has not requested the superior court to enter a stay pending appeal to this court, as generally required by Appellate Rule 205.

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED:** The motion is **HELD IN ABEYANCE** until Appellant files a stay motion in the superior court and the superior court rules on that motion. Appellant shall notify this court of the superior court's disposition of the superior court stay motion (including submitting a copy of any written ruling), at which time this court will take appropriate action on the stay motion before it. Appellant similarly should raise its request about a supersedeas bond to the superior court, per Appellate Rule 204(d).
