## **Order Rejecting Appellant's Brief**

Date of Order: **10/14/2019**

Trial Court Case No. **3PA-13-02000CI**

Appellant's brief and excerpt of record, filed on 9/23/2019, are rejected for the following reasons specified by the law clerk who reviewed the brief and excerpt for technical compliance with Appellate Rules 210 and 212.

### **Brief:**

1. The jurisdictional statement should give the date of final judgment and explain this court's authority to consider the appeal;
2. The Statement of the Case should include more factual citations to the record and excerpt. For example, most of the information on pages 2, 3, 4, and 5 should be cited;
3. The argument section should include more factual citations to the excerpt and record. For example, the last paragraph on page 32, the last two paragraphs on page 35, and the paragraph on page 36 starting with "In a motion *in limine* hearing" should include citations;
4. With the exception of divorce cases including property division, briefs are generally not supposed to include appendices. This brief includes three appendices;
5. References in the brief to the documents attached as appendices should be replaced with references to the appropriate pages of the record or excerpts.

1. The excerpt cover sheet is missing the nature of the proceeding (appeal) and the name of the court, judge, and case number below.
2. The excerpt should not be combined.

The original and one copy of the corrected brief, and the excerpt, with proof of service, are due on or before **10/28/2019**. Appellant shall also email .pdf versions of the brief and excerpt to [Mjohnson@akcourts.us](mailto:Mjohnson@akcourts.us) and [pleadings@akcourts.us](mailto:pleadings@akcourts.us). The appellee's brief due date of 10/21/2019 is vacated.
